Travel Arrangements:	Students in Soccer travel to and from the venue by hired bus. Students in Netball and AFL travel to and from the venue by light rail. If you wish for your child/ward to be dismissed from the venue, please sign your child/ward out with the class teacher upon your arrival. Please Note: If there is disruption to the light rail service, the netball and AFL games on that day will be forfeited and details will be sent out via the SchoolZine App. If the events are cancelled or arrangements altered for any reason, details will be sent out via the SchoolZine App.
Meal Arrangements:	Bring a refillable water bottle.

Uniform/ Dress Required:	Students need to wear their sports uniform and school hat. AFL students must wear a mouthguard to play. Soccer students must wear shin pads to play.

Important information

In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child/ward's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region and state school sport Associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child/ward's involvement in the program. Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets.

Parents/Carers who have private ambulance cover need to check whether that cover extends to interstate travel and make additional arrangements, as considered appropriate.

The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the loss of use of certain prescribed parts of the body. Concussion Clearance

The Australian Medical Association recommends students being symptom free of concussion for 14 days before returning to sport.
