Update Week Two

Welcome to Week Two Term Two,

The Department of Education is planning a phased return to school, and as mentioned previously whether students are learning from home or at school, one single unit of work will be provided. The teachers continue to work very hard to ensure these are available weekly and I thank all the parents and carers for their hard work supporting the children at home.

K-2 lessons will be available at 3pm Friday for Monday and Tuesday and 3pm Tuesday for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Years 3-6 lessons will be available at 3pm on Friday for the full week. Remember, if you have questions please email the school or submit questions through Google Classroom and teachers will get back to you as soon as possible.

Please see the link below for Kensington Public School's Phase One Managed Return to School. Where possible, families are encouraged to have their students attend on the **one designated day** and work from home the other four.

On days of attendance

Please ensure you send your children in their school uniform, school hat and their school shoes. As with normal school attendance students should arrive by 9am and if being picked up, should be picked at 3pm.

Play Equipment

Following NSW Health and Education advice, play equipment will be closed until further notice.

Food and Drink

Bubblers / drinking fountains remain closed, so please ensure your child attends school with a refillable drink bottle. Our

canteen remains closed so please ensure your children bring their lunch, morning tea and 'crunch and sip' on their days of attendance. We look forward to the canteen opening again soon.

Handwashing & Sanitiser

Currently the school has enough soap and hand sanitiser. Students are given multiple opportunities to wash or sanitise their hands, including before eating, before and after play times and of course after using the toilets. We have both liquid soap and bars of soap available for the students.

Arrival at School

As the DoE recommends, we will continue to limit adult access to the school grounds. Please see the Schoolzine Update Friday 24 April for current procedures. Below are the following drop off and pick up guidelines which start on Monday 11 May.

If you need to drop off or pick up anything from school, please email the school at Kensington-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au to organise a specific time for this. The most suitable time for this will be at 3pm at car lines.

Morning Drop Off from Week Three- Monday 11 May

When arriving at school, students are to enter through the North and or South Doncaster Avenue Gates or the Todman Avenue Gate where they will be greeted by a staff member and directed to put their bag under the COLA before washing hands. As normal, the students are to arrive between 8.30am and 9am. If you drive along Doncaster both gates will be open to ensure the cars can flow safely. Once inside, children will be directed by staff to the supervised area.

Afternoon Pick Up from Week Three- Monday 11 May

All students will come together at 2.55pm under the COLA. Gates will be unlocked at 3pm and students dismissed as adults remain outside the school's grounds alongside the netball court. Groups of students will be escorted to the car lines, OOSH and Squiggler Pick Up Zone. If your children walk home on their own, they will be dismissed under the guidance of the staff.

Keeping Up to Date

As we have all experienced in recent weeks, the current situation can change quickly. Therefore, more than ever it is important to keep up-to-date with school communications. Please ensure you have registered for the Schoolzine newsletter and app to get school notifications and regularly check the Department website and Twitter for up-to-date information.

All students, parents and teachers are currently working incredibly hard in this new world. Please remember some days will be better than others. Some days it may seem nothing is achieved. Please don't place additional pressure on yourselves to get every task completed and uploaded. Do your best. Do what's right for your family. If any family is experiencing difficulty with daily tasks and activities please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher via the school email kensington-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au. Students are not to be expected to work from 9am – 3pm at a computer. Be flexible, work can be completed around your work schedule and family needs.

Any student or family photos that were not collected last term, will be sent home with students on their day of attendance.

Remember, if you would like to submit photos or any of your activities, please email to the school and in the subject line write "School Newsletter" and that will be your approval for works to be published.
